

# Disproving Seventh-day Adventism

---

Sabbath-keeping is one of the Ten Commandments. The Ten Commandments are only part of the Mosaic Law; the Sacrifices and Ceremonial Ordinances making up the balance of the Law.

THE LAW was never given to the Gentiles (Exod., chs. 19, 20). The Gentiles were NEVER under the LAW (Eph. 2: 11, 12). SABBATH-KEEPING, as part of the LAW, was given to the Jews, and to them only (see Exod. 31: 17).

Jesus FULFILLED the demands of the LAW when He hung on the cross (Matt. 5:17). Jesus REDEEMED us from the curse of the LAW when He hung on the cross (Gal. 3: 13). Jesus ABOLISHED the LAW by His death on the cross (Eph. 2: 15). Jesus BLOTTED OUT all the ordinances of the LAW, including Sabbath-keeping, when He hung on the cross (Col. 2: 14). Jesus SLEW the enmity of the LAW when He hung on the cross (Eph. 2: 16).

The man or woman who attempts to keep the Jewish Sabbath is under obligation to keep ALL of the LAW (Gal. 3: 10). This includes all of the Ceremonial Ordinances as well. The Jewish people themselves cannot keep the LAW, having no longer any earthly high-priest, nor Temple worship.

Paul, the Apostle, says, "A man is NOT justified by the works of the LAW" (Gal. 2: 16). Paul says, "The just shall live by FAITH, and the LAW is NOT of faith"

(Gal. 3: 11). Paul says, "A man is justified by faith, **WITHOUT THE DEEDS OF THE LAW**" (Rom. 3:28). Paul says, "To him that worketh (sabbath-keeping) is the reward **NOT RECKONED OF GRACE BUT OF DEBT**. But to him that worketh **NOT**, but believeth on Him (Christ) that justifies the ungodly, his faith (your faith) is counted for righteousness" (Rom. 4: 4, 5).

Paul says, "For by **GRACE** are ye saved, through **FAITH**; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God: not of **WORKS**, lest any man should boast" (Eph. 2: 8, 9).

Paul says, "Christ is become of **NO** effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the **LAW**; ye are fallen from grace" (Gal. 5: 4).

Paul says, "Stand fast in the liberty wherewith Christ hath set us free, and be not entangled again **IN THE YOKE OF BONDAGE**" (the **LAW**) (Gal. 5: 1).

Paul says, "Let no man therefore judge you in meat, or in drink, or in respect of an holy day, or of the new moon, **OR OF THE SABBATH DAYS**" (Col. 2: 16).

Paul says, "God is not the Author of Confusion" (1 Cor. 14:33). But Seventh-day Adventism is **RANK CONFUSION** and contradiction.

The Commandments referred to by John the Apostle, in 1 John 5: 3, **ARE NOT THE COMMANDMENTS OF THE LAW**, as Seventh-day Adventism teaches, but are the commandments of the Lord Jesus Christ. John says these commandments "are **NOT** grievous."

Mary Baker Eddy, invented "Christian Science" (mental assassination). Mrs. White invented "Seventh-day Adventism." Jesus said, "The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, **WHICH A WOMAN TOOK**, and hid in three measures of meal, until the whole was leavened" (Matt. 13: 33). Leaven, in Scripture, always symbolizes **FALSE TEACHING**.

Some of Mrs. White's teachings are as follows: "There is no hell; the grave is hell." "The soul sleeps in the grave with the body, until Jesus comes back for it at the resurrection."

This is **NOT** the kind of a hell mentioned by the Lord Jesus in Luke 16. Here the rich man is in torment, begging for a drop of water to cool his tongue. The rich man is **NOT SOUL-SLEEPING** in this case!

Abraham was **NOT SOUL-SLEEPING** when the Lord Jesus said to the Jews, "Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, **AND HE SAW IT**, and was glad" (John 8: 56).

Moses was **NOT SOUL-SLEEPING** when he appeared on the Mount of Transfiguration and conversed with his Lord (Luke 9: 30).

The thief on the cross is not **SOUL-SLEEPING**, for Jesus said to him, "To-day shalt thou be with Me in Paradise" (Luke 23: 43).

Paul says he would "rather be absent from the body, and present with the Lord" (2 Cor. 5: 8). **No SOUL-SLEEPING** there!

Paul says again: "For I am in a strait betwixt two, having a desire to depart, and *to be with Christ*; which is far better. Nevertheless to abide in the flesh is more needful for you" (Phil. 1: 23, 24). **No SOUL-SLEEPING THERE!**

"All Gentile Seventh-day Adventists are **TRUE ISRAELITES**," says Mrs. White. Jesus says: "Behold I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews and are not, but **DO LIE**; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee" (Rev. 3: 9).

Sunday, the **FIRST DAY** of the week, is called the Lord's Day. It was on the **FIRST DAY** of the week that the Lord arose from the grave. It was on the **FIRST**

DAY of the week that He appeared to Mary Magdalene. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that He ascended to be glorified. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that He appeared to His Apostles. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that He breathed on them and said, "Receive ye the Holy Ghost." It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that He broke bread with His disciples, and ate it. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that He gave the great commission of the gospel to the Church. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that He walked and talked with the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that He ascended from Mount Olivet. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that the Apostles gathered together to break bread and remember the Lord Jesus in His death. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that the Holy Spirit came on the day of Pentecost. It was on the FIRST DAY of the week that the Apostle John was in the Spirit in the isle of Patmos, when he received the glorious vision recorded in Revelation.

The FIRST DAY of the week was the day set apart for special worship by the saints of God, LONG BEFORE CONSTANTINE WAS BORN, OR THE ROMAN CATHOLIC CHURCH WAS KNOWN.

Paul says: "Study (God's Word) to show thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, RIGHTLY DIVIDING THE WORD OF TRUTH" (2 Tim. 2: 15).
